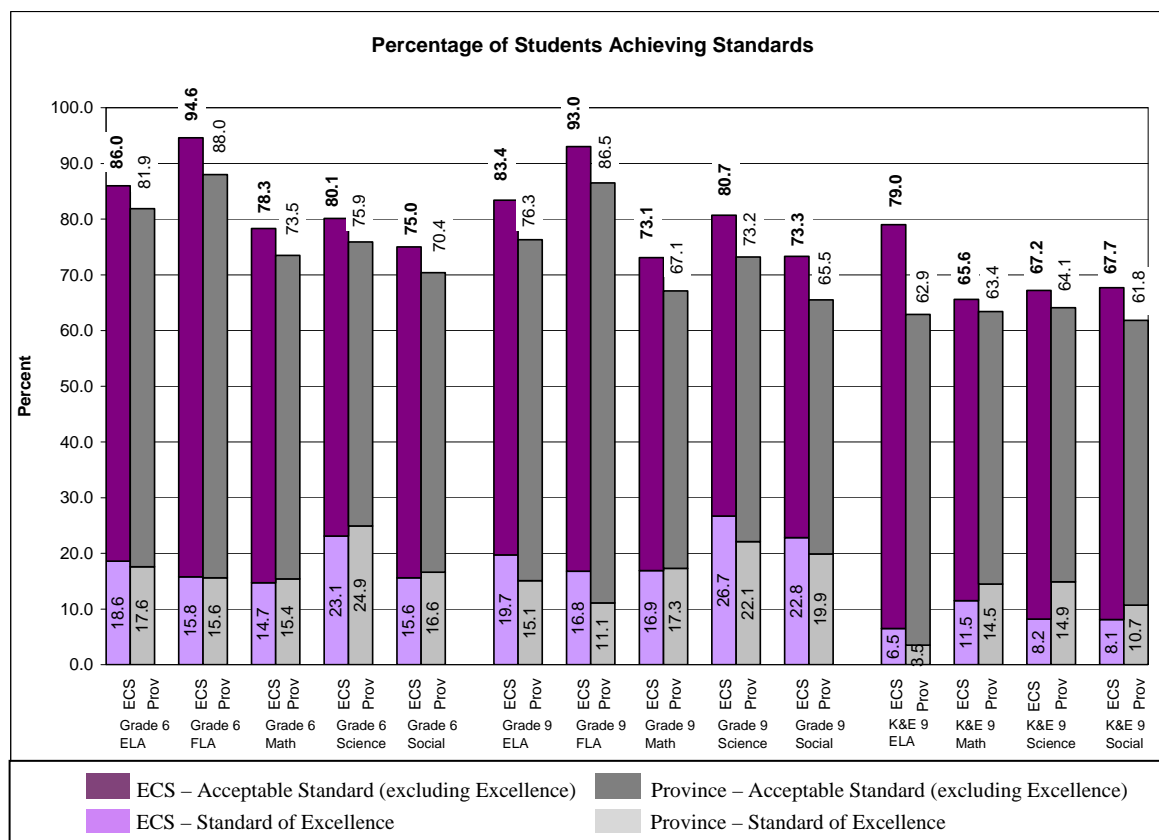


Provincial Achievement Test Results 2013/2014

Highlights*

- The percentage of Edmonton Catholic Schools' students achieving the **Acceptable Standard exceeded** the provincial percentage of students in **14 out of 14 standards (100%)**.
- The percentage of Edmonton Catholic Schools' students achieving the **Standard of Excellence exceeded** the provincial percentage of students in **7 out of 14 standards**.



- **Grade 6** students **exceeded** the provincial percentage of students achieving the **Acceptable Standard** in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**).
- **Grade 9** students **exceeded** the provincial percentage of students achieving the **Acceptable Standard** in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**).
- **Grade 9 K&E** students **exceeded** the provincial percentage of students achieving the **Acceptable Standard** in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**).

Edmonton Catholic Schools continued to have **higher participation rates** than the province in **ALL** subject areas (**14 out of 14**) (**100%**).

Overall, Edmonton Catholic Schools' students continue to exceed the province in a large number of subject areas.

* These results are based on full cohort aggregated English and French results for students in Grades 6 and 9 including Knowledge and Employability (K&E).

French Immersion Improvements**

Our Grade 6 French Immersion results have improved notably. Last year our Grade 6 French Immersion results were identified as areas of focus because they did not exceed the province in respect to the standards.

- This year our **Grade 6 French Immersion students exceeded** the provincial percentage of students achieving the **Acceptable Standard** in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**).
- In addition, our **Grade 6 French Immersion students exceeded** the provincial percentage of students achieving the **Standard of Excellence** in **2 out of 4** subject areas.
- In respect to the **Acceptable Standard**, the percentage of our Grade 6 French Immersion students increased in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**) from 2012/2013 to 2013/2014:
 - 10.7% in French Language Arts (from 83.9% to 94.6%)
 - 10.5% in Social Studies written in French (from 72.5% to 83.0%)
 - 8.8% in Science written in French (from 77.5% to 86.3%)
 - 8.0% in Mathematics written in French (from 77.5% to 85.5%)
- In respect to the **Standard of Excellence**, the percentage of our Grade 6 French Immersion students increased in **ALL** subject areas (**100%**) from 2012/2013 to 2013/2014:
 - 1.8% in Mathematics written in French (from 13.6% to 15.4%)
 - 1.7% in Science written in French (from 16.1% to 17.8%)
 - 1.4% in French Language Arts (from 14.4% to 15.8%)
 - 0.6% in Social Studies written in French (from 12.3% to 12.9%)

** These results are based on full cohort results for Grade 6 students writing in French.
