

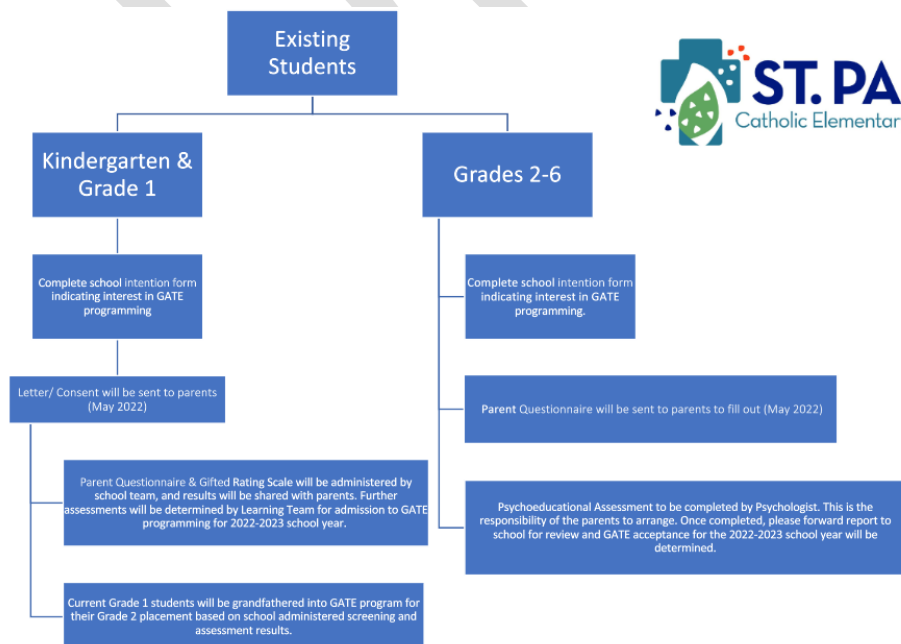
St. Paul School Council Meeting Minutes

 - Enrollment for St. Paul us projected at 175 students.

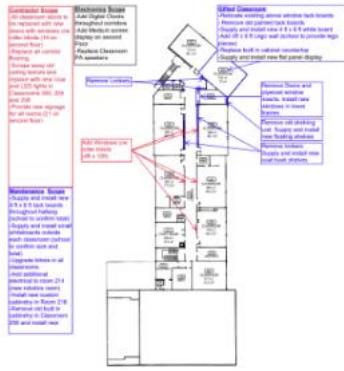
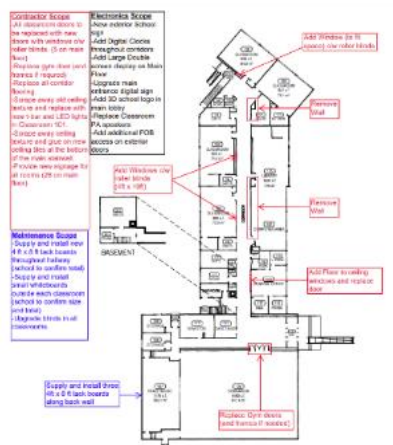


- Mrs. McNamee will contact those who were interested in the program (current students). Any questions can be directed to Mrs. Jones.

- Green Highlighted items are new - Washrooms are now being included into the renovation project. New Audio/Visual equipment also being completed. A grant was put in and likely be approved.



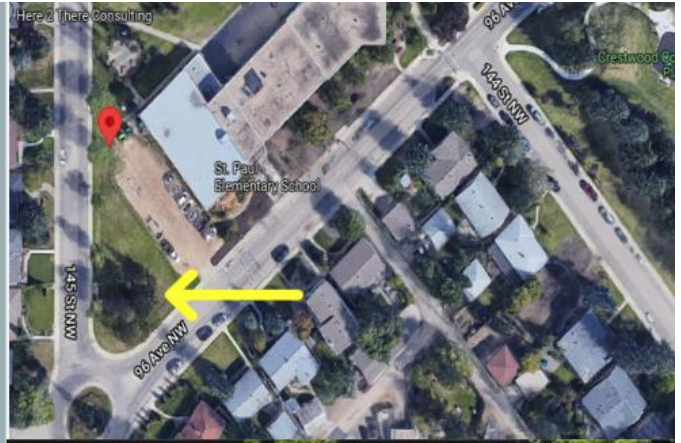
