Financial Empowerment Program

- This program is offered by the City of Edmonton and is for individuals and families who are looking to improve their financial situation.
- The services offered are **free and confidential**.
- You can meet with a social worker to talk about **financial problems, access support and services, problem solve, learn about benefits that may be available to you, or to prepare for tax filing**.
- This program is available Monday-Friday 8:30am-4:30pm and staff are reachable by telephone at (780)496-2800 or by email at communitywellness@edmonton.ca.



Edmonton Public Library - Brainfuse

- Brainfuse provides **learning support** to students Kindergarten to Grade 12.
- Students can access **online tutors** through a live chat and can create study aides customized to their learning needs.
- This program requires an Edmonton Public Library (EPL) membership, which is **free** to sign up for.
- The nearest EPL is Jasper Place at 9010 156 St and the branch can be reached at (780)496-1810.



WeCan Food Basket Society

- This program is like a “warehouse without walls”. By becoming a member you can enjoy access to **fresh and nutritious food at an affordable price**.
- How it works: **Membership is \$5** and runs from April-March. Once a member, you can place an order by the first Friday of the month to be included in that month's pick up. WeCan places the orders through a wholesale store that gives discounted rates that are shared amongst the members of the program.
- A **basket costs \$35** and includes frozen meats, fruits, and vegetables. WeCan seeks to purchase items that are in season and on sale.
