Exploring patterns

- identify repeating patterns
- sort objects based on a single attribute

Exploring Numbers

- describe orally, and compare quantities from 1 to 10

Exploring geometry and measurement

- use direct comparison to compare two objects

Develop attitudes and behaviours that promote a healthy lifestyle, wellness and safety for self and others
