Good afternoon Parents, Guardians and Grade 12 students:

First of all, we would like to take this opportunity to say thank you for the outstanding support of the Krispy Kreme fundraiser! We sold a record number of over 2300 boxes of donuts! More information will follow with pickup information but pick up dates will be November 18 and 23 and will be based on the student's last name.

As of now, the plan for the graduation is to hold a commencement on **Friday May 27, 2022 and a banquet on Saturday May 28, 2022, both at the Edmonton Convention Centre.** This will only change if COVID regulations are such that we are not permitted to hold this type of event.

We wanted to provide you with prior notice regarding the facility's vaccination protocol. The Edmonton Convention Centre requires proof of vaccination for all patrons and participants, which includes all attendees of the graduation events. **As such, in order to attend the Holy Trinity graduation, all eligible family members, as well as the graduates themselves, will be required to show proof of vaccination (or a listed alternative).**

Below is an excerpt from their policy:

- Proof of full vaccination (two doses) is required, with the second at least 14 days prior to the event, or
- Negative COVID-19 test that is Health Canada approved rapid antigen, rapid PCR or lab-based PCR tests completed within 72 hours, or
- Formal documentation of a medical exemption as defined on the Alberta government's COVID-19 public health actions | Alberta.ca site.

Patrons includes: Any member of the public entering the Convention Centre to attend an event.

Participant includes: All volunteers, workers, show staff, exhibitors or suppliers participating in the event during public event hours.

Public event hours: Defined as the period of time when patrons have access to enter the event space or show floor.

On-site Rapid Testing: On-site rapid testing for participants will be available to clients who wish to offer this alternative. This will be at an additional cost to the guest.



Masks will continue to be required in compliance with Alberta Government guidelines.

We trust that we will have the support of our families as we work to create a safe graduation event that will truly celebrate the hard work and dedication of the Class of 2022.
