Teachers will be communicating specifics about each class's plans soon so please check your child's agenda and your email for more information as it is made available.</li></ul> <p>As students are planning their day at school, please note some of the following guidelines this year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ We ask that students refrain from bringing weapon accessories (i.e., toy guns, knives, ninja throwing stars, etc.).</li><li>◦ Hands must be free to be sanitized therefore, hand coverings must be detachable.</li><li>◦ Parents, unfortunately, will <u>not</u> be allowed into the school this year. Therefore, students in Grades 1-6 need to be able to dress into their costume themselves. If makeup needs to be completed, we welcome you to do it at home prior to coming to school in the morning.</li><li>◦ If students are planning to bring treats for their classmates this day, all treats will need to be store bought and individually packaged. Students will be sent home with these treats so that parents can decide when and what their child can consume.</li></ul>
