Good afternoon.

Halloween is almost here and we can tell that the students are getting excited!

As students are planning their day at school, please note some of the following guidelines this year:

- We ask that students refrain from bringing weapon accessories (i.e., toy guns, knives, ninja throwing stars, etc.).
- Hands must be free to be sanitized or to wash, therefore, hand coverings must be detachable.
- Parents, unfortunately, will not be allowed into the school this year. Therefore, students in Grades 1-6 need to be able to dress into their costume themselves. If makeup needs to be completed, we welcome you to do it at home prior to coming to school in the morning. Kindergarten students are invited to wear their costume to school in the morning.
- If students are planning to bring treats for their classmates this day, all treats will need to be store bought and individually packaged. Students will be sent home with these treats so that parents can decide when and what their child can consume.
- We have a rule that students are allowed **3 pieces of candy per day** at school. If a student is found to have more (in backpack, lunch, pockets, etc.), we do take the candy for the day and return it at the end of the day *the first time*. If we do find this to happen again, candy/treats are taken and not returned. Please help us to keep our students learning during this fun season.
