Re: Potential School Consolidation for Katherine Therrien Catholic Elementary School and St. Lucy Catholic Elementary School

Dear ECSD Families,

Edmonton Catholic School Division (ECSD) would like to provide an update about the potential consolidation of two schools, Katherine Therrien Catholic Elementary School and St. Lucy Catholic Elementary School, and the creation of a new Junior High attendance boundary located in the Castle Downs/northwest sector of Edmonton.

ECSD believes all students should have equitable access to quality and vibrant learning environments, and we are excited about the opportunity of re-investing in the northwest sector communities. The project would create a new K-9 school with a capacity of 950 in the neighbourhood of Oxford. It will not only create much-needed Junior High space within this area but also bring the school closer to where the majority of students live. Earlier this year, the project was moved to priority number five on our [Three-Year 2023-2026 Capital Plan](#).
