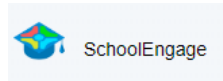


# The Enhanced Academic Program (EAP) Application is a *student* filled form, not a parent.

The Enhanced Academic Program (EAP) enhances Knowledge Development and prepares students for mastery in foundational, subject-specific content. Character Development by developing honesty, integrity, and self-reliance through the application of their knowledge and skills. Community Engagement by enhancing their understanding of diverse communities and identify connections that transcend difference. Within EAP, students will develop and apply the Alberta Education Competencies, including critical thinking, problem solving, managing information, Creativity and innovation, communication, collaboration, cultural and global citizenship and personal growth and well-being, which can lead towards successful learning, living, and working. The junior high years can provide a powerful opportunity for students to acquire the skills, habits of mind and concepts they need to engage in higher levels of learning. The EAP program prepares students for Advanced Placement courses in high school. Characteristics of an EAP student are:

1. Eager to be challenged
2. Able to complete tasks in a timely manner
3. Highly self-directed
4. Curious about many things and interested in learning about them
5. Analytical about their own education and open to personal growth as a learner
6. Prepared to work collegially with their peers
7. Willing to develop public speaking and presentation skills

After Submitting the status on the main page will change to Approved. This doesn't mean that the student is Approved, it means that the system automatically accepted and transferred the form to PowerSchool. This is a wording quirk of SchoolEngage and will be changed in the next version.
