COMMUNICATION

PROTOCOL FOR PARENT CONCERNS

St. Mary School and all Edmonton Catholic Schools recognize the freedom of all members of the school community (students, staff, parents, and neighbors) to voice their concerns in an appropriate manner to the appropriate school personnel.

All parties in a conflict situation must recognize and respect the protocol, and more specifically, the principle of “first contact.” This means that the person(s) who has the concern has a responsibility to begin addressing it **first** directly with those persons with whom they have the problem. If the issue is not resolved, you are then invited to speak directly to the Principal (Administrative Regulation 132).
