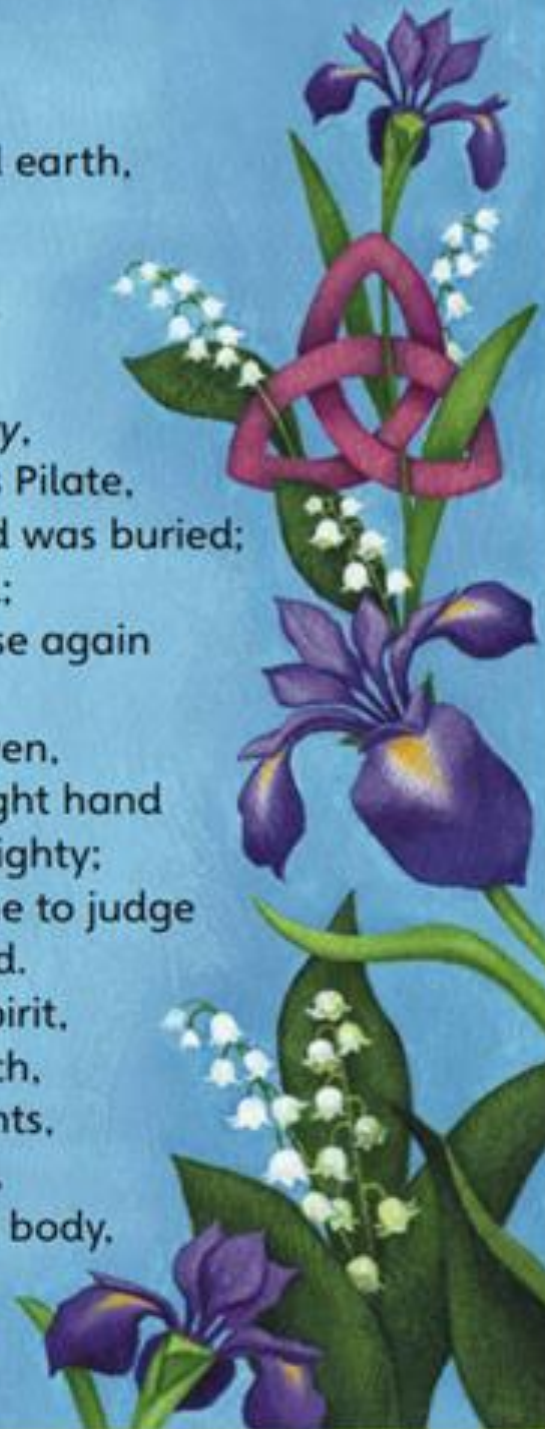
Posters come from Grades 1-3 resources in *Growing in Faith, Growing in Christ*, and are intended for family use.

Amen.

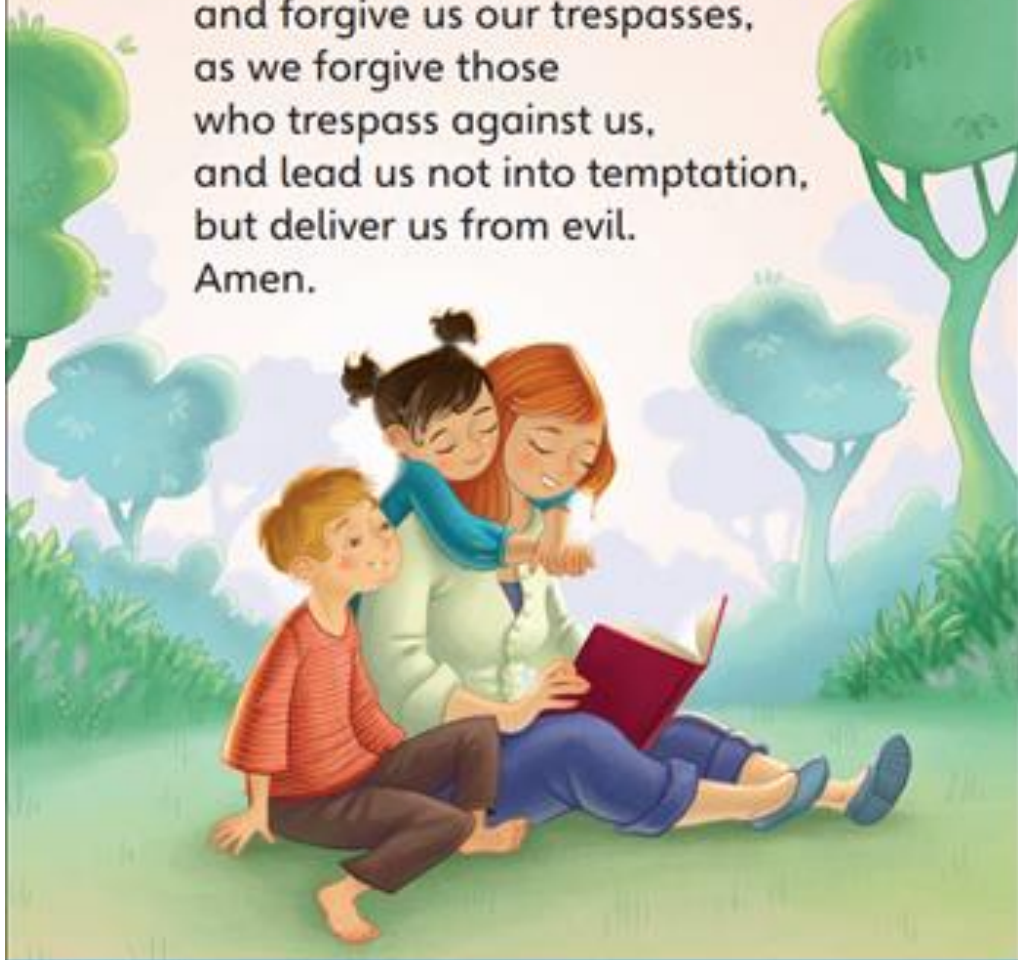


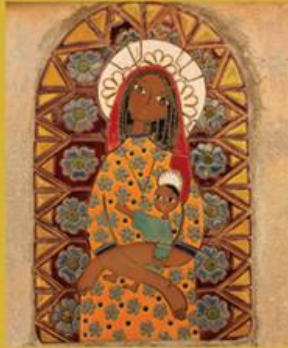


## The Lord's Prayer
